ROSARY RECITED: The Rosary is being said prior to weekday morning Mass at 8am, including Sundays. Everyone is invited to come and prayer for world peace.



PASCHAL PRECEPT

Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This is to be done between Ash Wednesday (22 February 2023) and Trinity Sunday (4 June 2023) unless for a good reason it is done at another time during the year.

All the faithful are obliged to **confess** their grave sins at least once a year.

DAYS OF PENANCE

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

- All who are 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat.
- All who are 18 to 59 years of age are obliged to fast (Canon 1252).
- All have an overall moral obligation "to do penance".
- Anyone who is sick or infirm are not obliged by these laws.
