The parable of the woman placing leaven in three measures of flour is an intriguing one. In some translations, the text reads, "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven which a woman took and hid in three measures of flour, till it was all leavened." Whilst you might initially hide yeast in some dough, it doesn't take very long for the yeast to become apparent as it makes the dough rise. Such a large quantity of flour suggests the bread is being prepared for a festival – perhaps Passover when only unleavened bread was used? That would put a different spin on the woman's action!

LATEST DIRECTIVES FROM BISHOP BRIAN

1 July 2020

- *The total number of people allowed to attend* 1) Mass is now replaced by the rules of social dis tancing—4 square metres of space for each per Tahmoor church has capacity for just over 100 people.
- 2) First time Mass goers must have their names and contact phone number recorded with the parish, prior to attending. After that please have your named checked off when entering the church, on each occasion, that you attend.

You are not required to pre register for weekday Mass.

Those who cannot attend Mass, can continue to nurture their faith through watching Mass on line or other prayerful means.

- + If you are 65years+ and have underlying health concerns or 70+ years please consider staying at home for your safety
- tizer when entering the Church.
- When leaving please leave your kneeler down, so those areas can be cleaned.
- + Offering (Sunday Mass only) is to be placed in boxes provided (mounted on wall) at the entrances, as you enter the Church or after Mass, or ideally given through direct debit.

Collection plates will no longer be passed around to avoid spread of germs/viruses.

- + No longer holy water in the bowl at the entrance door.
- + Please do not touch any statutes/paintings/icons
- + Not to shake hand at any event.
- + Holy Communion given into the hand only and in one line.
- 3) Reconciliation/Confession: by appointment with Fr. Peter (his phone: 0406001540.)
- Baptism: by appointment either on Saturday or 4) Sunday
- 5) You are encouraged to install the COVID-19 App onto your mobile phone.
